Sad Gnome Records, in collaboration with New Jersey's *Abaton Book Company*, is proud to present the first UK/European vinyl release by **Marianne Nowottny & The All American Band**.

A 4-track ep playing at 33 1/3 rpm, MN&TAAB kicks off with All Over The World, a lovely slice of quirky folktronica taken from the acclaimed album What Is She Doing? Second track Ain't Gonna Be Pretty successfully bridges the gap between avant garde and catchy pop, and will appeal to fans of Marianne's earlier 'difficult' output as well as the hip, indiecentric kid looking for groovy experimental electro beats. Flipping over, Mr. So & So is a manic and fantastic hip-hop tinged reworking of another album track, this time in German. Closer Love Is Just A Dream introduces brash guitars into the mix, serving to enhance the sweetest of melodies.

Ms. Nowottny came to the attention of New York avant garde music and art circles in 1998, at the age of sixteen, with the release of **Afraid of Me**, described as "one of the most astonishing debuts ever" by *New York Press*. She has since released CDs on *Camera Obscura*, *Foxy Digitalis*, *Barl Fire* and *Celestial Jars*. She has garnered additional glowing reviews in such publications as *WIRE*, *The New York Times* and *Signal To Noise*.

This release is the first to present her new trio, The All American Band which features Stirling Krusing (*Flaming Fire*, *AAAA Locksmiths & Bail Bonds*) & Mark Dagley (*Pothole Skinny*, *Hi Sheriffs*, *Girls*).

Marianne Nowottny & The All American Band will delight all who hunger after primitive electro beats & bass, low budget keyboards & guitars, spacey electronics and a inimitable female voice.
